The following additional question was received on this contract. The response this additional question is provided in bold after the question.


IMPORTANT NOTE: All prospective consultants must acknowledge the clarifications, revisions, additions and/or deletions for this Expression of Interest by attaching both **Addendums No. 1 and No. 2** to the front of their Expression of Interest submittal. Failure to attach both **Addendums No. 1 and No. 2** to the front of the Expression of Interest submittal may result in rejection.

Q1: Addendum No. 1 dated June 17th, Question 9 asked if Item #9 of the SF 255 is required. The response was yes but that it should be answered for "federal agencies". The Item #9 has always been required to include current work for MDOT. Is it the intent that the Item #9 should only address current work for federal agencies for this submittal?

A1: Additional clarification: Projects funded with federal funds can be listed in Item #9.

REMINDER: The Expression of Interest due date for BCS 2012-19 was **REVISED** in Addendum No. 1. The **REVISED** due date is by **4:00 P.M. on July 11, 2013.** Expression of Interests received after the **REVISED** deadline time will not be accepted no matter how transmitted and will be returned unopened to the Consultant.
