EXPRESSION OF INTEREST ADDENDUM No. 1

To All Consultant Candidates:

Please be advised that the Expression of Interest submittal due date for contract BCS 2012-19 has been **REVISED** from June 27, 2013 to **July 11, 2013 by 4:00 PM.**

The following questions were received on this contract. The response to each question received is provided in bold after each question. All prospective consultants must acknowledge the clarifications, revisions, additions and/or deletions listed below for this Expression of Interest Addendum No. 1 by attaching this addendum to the front of their Expression of Interest submittal.

Q1: Is there a page limit (1) on the SF 255 item #10?

A1: Item #10 is non-applicable. There is no item #10 for BCS 2012-19.

Q2: Trying to confirm there is no Item #10 – including the signature?

A2: There is no Item #10 for this contract. The signature is Item #11 and is required.

Q3: Is there a DBE form to be completed with this submittal?

A3: No. Said information shall be shown in Item #6 of the Federal Government SF 255 form.

Q4: Must the Iran Certification form be submitted as part of the Expression of Interest submission?

A4: Yes.


Q5: On page 10 of the RFP it states that “An officer of the firm shall provide a signed original certification” for the Investment Activities in Iran and that there is a BPW Advisory Sample. Could you please tell me where I could find the sample so I may include it in our proposal?

A11: The ad states the two key staff positions of Construction Manager and Construction Engineer both must meet the stated SHA Specifications as well as demonstrate 15 years of experience. The following experience clarification on experience requirements are stated below for both these positions:

- **Construction Manager: Shall meet SHA's Specifications for Transportation Engineer Manager II. Either of the following are acceptable:**
 - Possession of a bachelor's degree in engineering from an accredited college or university and a minimum experience of eight (8) years of professional experience including two (2) years of supervisory experience – or -
 - Twelve years work experience in the professional engineering or technical engineering at the journey level or above including two (2) years of supervisory experience.
 - **Note: One year of supervisory experience may be substituted if the person has a Master's Degree in engineering.**
- **Construction Engineer: Shall meet SHA's Specifications for Transportation Engineer V. Either of the following are acceptable:**
 - Possession of a bachelor's degree in engineering from an accredited college or university and a minimum experience of five (5) years of experience in professional engineering – or -
 - Nine years work experience in professional engineering.
 - **Note: One year of experience may be substituted if the person has a Master's Degree in engineering.**

REMINDER: The Expression of Interest due date for BCS 2012-19 has been **REVISED**. The **REVISED** due date is by **4:00 P.M. on July 11, 2013**. Expression of Interests received after the **REVISED** deadline time will not be accepted no matter how transmitted and will be returned unopened to the Consultant.
