

All prospective Consultants must acknowledge the clarifications, revisions, additions and/or deletions listed below for this Expression of Interest Addendum No. 1 by attaching this addendum to the front of their Expression of Interest submittal. Failure to attach Addendum No. 1 to the front of the Expression of Interest submittal and to all Expression of Interest copies may result in rejection.

CONSULTANT QUESTIONS

- Q1: Are key staff submissions from sub-consultants permitted to be used on more than one team? Example: "John Doe" is employed by a sub-consultant (which may/may not be a DBE). Can "John Doe" be listed as a key staff for multiple teams as indicated on page 7 - Key Staff #3, 4, and 6? (i.e. Consultant #1 lists "John Doe" as Key Staff #3 and Consultant #2 also lists "John Doe" as Key Staff #3).
- A1: **Key Staff submissions are permitted to be used as a Key Staff member for multiple teams (contracts) as long as the Key Staff member can fulfill all of the commitments under all of the contracts for which the Key Staff member is being proposed.**
- Q2: Will there be a pre-bid conference for this project?
- A2: **No.**
