## MD 175 BRAC Widening at Fort George G. Meade

**WHERE:** Fort George G. Meade / Anne Arundel County

**WHAT:** Widening a one-mile section of MD 175 between Reece Road and Disney Road from an existing two-lane undivided highway to a six-lane divided highway. The project includes sidewalks, bicycle lanes and a hiker/biker trail that will eventually extend from MD 295 to MD 170 in Odenton. Currently, 25,900 vehicles travel along MD 175 in this area each day, with traffic projected to increase to 65,700 vehicles daily by 2030.

**WHY:** This project will enhance traffic safety, capacity and operations along MD 175 and improve access to Fort George G. Meade, which is a vital component needed to accommodate the increase of employment resulting from BRAC.

**WHEN:** Design is underway. Construction is scheduled to start in fall 2016.
