




## Preservation of Ramp from Northbound Hanover Street to Southbound I-95

Work Includes 60-Day Ramp Closure Beginning On or About May 2, 2011



### Project Description:

A \$1.5-million project is underway to rehabilitate and repair the ramp from northbound Hanover Street to southbound I-95 in Baltimore City. The project is scheduled to be complete by June 30, 2011.

### Work Zone:

Construction begins at Hanover Street just prior to the ramp to southbound I-95 and includes the Hanover Street ramp and portions of McComas Street. Travel lanes will not be affected on I-95.

### Traffic Impacts:

- A 60-day complete ramp closure beginning on or about May 2, 2011. Additional periodic lane closures on Hanover Street may be necessary.
- The detour will direct motorists to northbound McComas Street, to a u-turn onto southbound McComas Street, to southbound I-95 (see map).

### Work on the Ramp Includes:

- Milling and overlay of the ramp's bridge deck,
- Installing bridge-mounted steel sight barrier,
- Modifying the existing roadway joints,
- Painting structural steel,
- Repairing concrete parapet walls, and
- Miscellaneous structural repairs.
