- A1: The work of the Hydraulics Engineer can be better performed if they have had experience working on hydraulics portion of highway/roadway projects. Their work is directly related to the geometrics of the highways, and ped & bike facilities. They need to have an understanding and experience of handling such projects. They design for all highway/roadway drainage facilities including pedestrian and bicycle paths. The hydraulics engineer adequately sizes drainage facilities to convey design flows across highways and other associated facilities within the right of way.
