From the Governor of the State of Maryland

WORK ZONE AWARENESS MONTH APRIL 2021

WHEREAS,

Even in the midst of a national health crisis, the Maryland Department of Transportation State Highway Administration continues to perform important inspection, maintenance and construction work that has been critical now more than ever to keeping the supply chain moving, getting essential employees to work safely and efficiently, and ensuring a well-maintained highway system that provides paths to opportunity and keeps Maryland open for business; and

WHEREAS,

With the appropriate health practices and protocols in place, Maryland will have an active construction season, and we must protect our team members as they courageously work along our roadways to improve the safety and quality of life of those traveling Maryland's highways; and

WHEREAS,

We recognize those who work in roadway construction and maintenance, as well as traffic engineers, traffic operations personnel, toll workers, law enforcement officers, emergency personnel and others whose work environments include the open road and we honor those who have been injured or lost in the line of duty; and

Maryland is raising drivers' awareness of the need to slow down, stay alert, avoid distractions and obey signs and flag persons in work zones to prevent crashes and injuries that injure workers, drivers and passengers.
