Proclamation

From the Governor of the State of Maryland

WORK ZONE AWARENESS WEEK

APRIL 21st-25th, 2025

WHEREAS, Maryland prioritizes safety along its roadways as crews perform the essential work to construct, improve and maintain a safe and reliable transportation system that provides paths to opportunities for all; and

WHEREAS, As we strive toward reducing injuries and fatalities on Maryland's roadways, we honor all who have been injured and all who have lost their lives in work zone crashes; and

WHEREAS, Maryland is dedicated to raising awareness on the importance of driving safely in work zones and protecting our construction crews, maintenance workers, traffic operations personnel, law enforcement officers and emergency personnel so they can make it home safely to their families at the end of the day; and


WHEREAS, Most work zone crashes are preventable, and Maryland is committed to reduce speeding, encourage responsible driving behaviors and save lives; and

WHEREAS, Speed limits in many work zones are reduced and are clearly posted as well as enforced and motorists are urged to slow down, move over, stay alert, avoid distractions and obey signage when approaching and passing through a roadway work zone; and

WHEREAS, We ask all to wear orange on Wednesday, April 23, Go Orange Day, in support of work zone safety.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WES MOORE, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, do hereby proclaim APRIL 21st-25th, 2025 as WORK ZONE AWARENESS WEEK in Maryland and call upon the people of our state to join in this observance.
