From the Governor of the State of Maryland
GO ORANGE AND HIGHWAY WORKER APPRECIATION DAY
APRIL 13, 2022

- WHEREAS,** *The people of Maryland recognize those who work along our State's roadways to ensure a safe, well-maintained roadway system that provides paths to opportunity for all; and*
- WHEREAS,** *Maryland will have a very active construction season, with hundreds of projects underway, and highway workers perform an essential public safety service and courageously work in difficult environments and extreme conditions; and*
- WHEREAS,** *We recognize those who work in highway construction and maintenance, as well as traffic engineers, traffic operations personnel, toll workers, law enforcement officers, emergency personnel and others whose work environments include the open road and we honor those who have been injured or lost in the line of duty; and*
- WHEREAS,** *Throughout the Nation, all citizens are asked to slow down, stay alert, avoid distractions and obey signs and flag persons in work zones to prevent crashes that injure workers, drivers and passengers.*
