The State Highway Administration (SHA) is pleased to forward its Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliance status report to the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA). This letter highlights SHA's 2024 accomplishments and efforts made during that calendar year.

The SHA advanced the design of 23 projects that will bring approximately 11.3 miles of existing sidewalk into full ADA compliance through the Sidewalk Reconstruction for Pedestrian Access Program under Fund 33. The attached report reflects the projects in design in five counties, representing four of SHA's districts. Although we have not completed any construction projects in calendar year 2024, we are actively developing and implementing our strategic plans for future initiatives. As of December 31, 2024, SHA has achieved ADA compliance in the following areas along our state roadway system:
