
AASHTO Domestic Materials Self-Certification Form – Maryland Supplemental Guidance

The purpose of the [AASHTO Domestic Materials Self-Certification Form \(DMSCF\)](#) is to certify that iron or steel products, or construction materials, or manufactured products used on a project are in compliance with the applicable domestic materials content procurement preferences found in the Buy America Act requirements ([23 CFR 635.420](#)) and the Build America, Buy America (BABA) requirements ([2 CFR Part 184](#)).

A copy of the [DMSCF](#) is currently available at [Domestic Materials Self-Certification Form \(DMSCF\)](#). The Maryland State Highway Administration (SHA) is providing guidance to assist with the use of the [DMSCF](#).

Maryland SHA Supplemental Guidance on the [DMSCF](#)

Purpose

To provide:

1. Information and guidance on additional details related to the [DMSCF](#).
2. Some clarifications to enhance project construction.

General Clarifications

1. The [Domestic Materials Self-Certification Form \(DMSCF\)](#) must be completed and certified by the Producer/Manufacturer of the articles, materials, or supplies.
2. In addition to submitting the completed [DMSCF](#), the Contractor/Supplier is required to ensure that the material, article, or supply complies with the Material Quality Assurance requirements as per the:
 - a. Maryland Standard Specifications for Construction and Materials
 - b. Maryland Product Evaluation Listing (MPEL)
 - c. Material Quality Assurance Processes, Details and Frequencies
 - d. Approved Project Documents.
3. The Prime Contractor shall provide the required material certifications and the [DMSCF](#) to the Engineer prior to such items being incorporated into the permanent work and before any payment for the material.
