Description: MD 24 - Section A, from Deer Creek Bridge to 1,800 feet South of the bridge; and Section G, from 900 feet South of Sharon Road to 1,700 feet North of Ferncliff Lane

The RFP is for a Construction Management at Risk (CMAR) contract procured using the "Competitive Sealed Proposals" procurement method as defined in the Code of Maryland Regulations (COMAR) 21.05.03. The SHA is seeking a qualified Contractor to provide Preconstruction Services as defined in the RFP including, but not limited to, constructability analysis, value analysis, scheduling, site assessments, and cost estimating. Upon a Contract amendment with SHA to deliver the project at an agreed upon guaranteed maximum price, the Contractor would act as a general contractor during the construction phase of the project.

Maryland 24 (Rocks Road) is a major rural highway located in Harford County, Maryland. Deer Creek, classified as a wild and scenic river, parallels MD 24 from the Stirrup Run Culvert to Deer Creek Bridge. The purpose of the project is to improve the road safety by remediating the slopes supporting MD 24 within the project limits, repairing the pavement, improving roadway drainage, and addressing roadside safety concerns. The potential scope of construction work may include construction of retaining walls, HMA reconstruction and resurfacing, drainage improvements, installation of traffic barrier, maintenance of traffic, erosion and sediment control, and signing and pavement marking.
