The purpose of this Notice is to advise Contractors that the State Highway Administration (SHA) will be holding an INFORMATIONAL MEETING on the following CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AT RISK (CMAR) project:

• Greenbelt Metro Access (I-95/I-495) - US 1 to Baltimore / Washington Parkway

CMAR is an alternative project delivery method in which a Contractor is procured utilizing the Competitive Sealed Proposal process to provide a range of preconstruction services to SHA during the design phase of a project. These services may include, but are not limited to, constructability analysis, value engineering, scheduling, site assessments, and cost estimating. The Contractor would act as a general contractor during the construction phase upon agreement with SHA to deliver the project at a Guaranteed Maximum Price.

Project Description:

The project is located in Prince George's County along I-95/I-495 (Capital Beltway) and begins just east of US 1 and ends just east of the Baltimore / Washington (B/W) Parkway. The project proposes to reconstruct the partial interchange between I-95/I-495 and the Greenbelt Metro Station with a full interchange and add auxiliary lanes along I-95/I-495 between US 1 and the B/W Parkway. The project will also reconstruct the I-95/495 inner and outer loop bridges over Rhode Island Avenue and the inner loop bridge over MD 193.

The scope of the project is anticipated to include grading, pavement construction, bridge construction, culvert construction, retaining walls, bridge removal, noise walls, sidewalk, drainage, storm water management and erosion and sediment control, maintenance of traffic, maintenance of stream flow, signing and marking, lighting, wetland and stream mitigation, landscaping, and reforestation.
